- This contest is limited to students currently enrolled in an academic agency (i.e., school, after-school program, etc.). All grade levels are welcome to participate.
- All submissions must include:
  - pdf file of an **original** 2-inch diameter design
  - contact information
  - a design rationale
  - the artist's biography (must fill out the Google form link below)
  - A signed media consent form
    - Artists under the age of 18 must submit a media consent form signed by a parent/guardian.
- All required documents must be submitted by **Wednesday, April 15, 2026**, for the submission to be considered.
- All designs must be original work by the submitting artist.
- Winner(s) will be announced on **Friday, May 15, 2026**.
